



FROM YOUR PARISH PRIESTS

Dear friends,

The announcement on January 4 by Archbishop ListECKI that the Archdiocese of Milwaukee was filing for bankruptcy came after some of our parish bulletins had already gone to press. Since we did not have the opportunity to communicate with you then, we would like to take this opportunity to convey a few thoughts to you.

As you can imagine, the archbishop’s announcement has prompted more than a few questions from parishioners. Some have asked us if we knew this was in the works. We did not. We were informed of this action via email about an hour prior to the archbishop’s news conference on January 4th. Other parishioners have asked us to share our impressions or to speculate on how this might unfold. Truth be told, this is something completely new for all of us, including your three pastors. We know that we do not have all of the information and so any insights that we might share could end up being wrong. The last thing that the three of us want to do is create more confusion or to occasion more mistrust by something we might say.

Therefore, we are going to do our best to share with you all of the communications that will come from the archdiocese and Archbishop ListECKI. If you were out of town last weekend, a recorded message from Archbishop ListECKI was played at all masses and three inserts were included in the bulletin. All of those resources, as well as many others, can be found on the archdiocesan website: www.archmil.org. We

would encourage you to visit this site often to keep abreast of developments as this process moves forward. The site also affords you the opportunity to pose questions to the archdiocese that will be answered on the website.

It is presumed that this process could take up to two years to complete. During this time, our commitment to you is that we will continue doing what has been done in our parishes since they were founded, namely, we will continue to offer mass, hear confessions, baptize children, marry those who are engaged and bury those who have died. We will continue to educate and form parishioners of all ages in our Catholic Faith and we will continue to reach out to the poor. This is the work of the Church. These are the works we are proud to be in engaged in as your pastors.

We thank you for the many assurances of prayers, love and support that we have received from so many parishioners. We hope that you all know how much we also love you and that we remember you in our prayers as well. In the midst of the anxiety and uncertainty that will be with us in the months ahead, let’s join together in continuing the work that makes us Church: proclaiming and living the message of Jesus Christ.


