Are you Expecting a Baby? Want to Have your Child Baptized?



Congratulations! We are so happy that you're here, and would like to help your family become part of our parish life. To have your baby baptized here, it's good to plan ahead. For first time parents, you need to attend a Baptism preparation session. These are offered every month, usually on the third

Thursday evening of the month from 6:30-8:00 p.m. at the Old Saint Mary parish center. **OUR NEXT SESSION IS MAY 19TH.** Parents often find it easiest to do this before the baby is born, and you're encouraged to participate soon! For all baptisms, Godparents are asked to read our godparent guide, complete a commitment form, and return it to the parish office. Before baptism dates can be set for any baptism, we must first receive the godparent commitment forms back from the godparents. Before baptisms are scheduled for a first child, both a baptism class and the godparent forms must be completed.

Living Rosary – Wednesday May 25th 7pm at Holy Rosary Church

The Living Rosary will be prayed publicly on **Wednesday May 25th at 7pm at Holy Rosary church.** The Living Rosary is a special way to pray the Rosary. 50 participants are given a lit candle and represent one of the 'beads' of the Rosary. The 'rosary' moves around the church as we pray the 5 decades.

As the Second Vatican Council pointed out so clearly, the life of the Church centers on the Sunday Eucharist. However, the Council also pointed out that the spiritual life "is not limited solely to participation in the liturgy...according to the teaching of the apostle, the Christian must pray without ceasing."
