Are you Expecting a Baby? Want to Have your Child Baptized?



Congratulations! We are so happy that you're here, and would like to help your family become part of our parish life. To have your baby baptized here, it's good to plan ahead. For first time parents, you need to attend a Baptism preparation session. These are offered every month, usually on the third Thursday evening of the month from 6:30-8:00 p.m. at the Old Saint Mary parish center.

OUR NEXT SESSION IS JUNE 16TH. Parents often find it easiest to do this before the baby is born, and you're encouraged to participate soon! For all baptisms, Godparents are asked to read our godparent guide, complete a commitment form, and return it to the parish office. Before baptism dates can be set for any baptism, we must first receive the godparent commitment forms back from the godparents. Before baptisms are scheduled for a first child, both a baptism class and the godparent forms must be completed.
