FROM YOUR PARISH PRIESTS

**“At present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face. At present I know partially, then I shall know fully, as I am fully known. So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love.”**

*(From St. Paul’s First Letter to the Corinthians, ch. 13)*

Dear Friends,

This Sunday’s famous second reading, used often in weddings, runs the risk of being like a song we like which we have heard over and over again, beautiful but so worn we forget its meaning.

We cannot read this beautiful tribute to love, though, without immediately being moved from a touchy-feely reaction to a down-to-the-depths-of-your-being **challenge**. Love, we are reminded, goes so much further than just what we are feeling, to who we really are and how we really are called to live. Really loving someone entails sacrifice, especially in the little day-to-day things. Real love sometimes means living in a way opposite of what we really feel like doing. Ask someone who loves if they always *like* their beloved, and you might be surprised by the answer.

I heard a quote once that character is defined as

what you do when you think nobody is watching. I would expand that to the reality that a person who truly loves is measured by how he or she acts even when they don’t feel the fuzzy glow. The deep satisfaction of life lived in these complicated times is that in the clarity of heaven we will look back and realize we did the right thing in being merciful, patient, kind, bearing all things, believing in possibilities, hoping in despair, and enduring the imprecision of being human.

Good challenges in the midst of winter—warmed not by the warm fuzzies, but by the fire of truth and the love of the source and pattern of all love, Jesus Christ!
