FROM YOUR PARISH PRIESTS

Dear friends,

Father Tim and I would like to extend our sincere thanks to the many, many parishioners who helped make our celebration of the Sacred Triduum as wonderful as it was.

Now that Lent and the Triduum have passed, it is time for us to move into a very busy Spring. Over the course of the next two months, we will need to choose new members to serve on our parish council. As we did last year, we will be using a discernment process to select three new members to serve a three-year term on parish council. Let me explain how this works.

The weekend of **April 24-25** will be **Nomination Weekend**. All registered members of the parish will be invited to nominate either themselves or other parishioners to serve on council. In order to serve on parish council, the person must be baptized, Roman Catholic, 18 years old or older, a registered and active member of the parish, and not employed as a parish staff member.

Once we have collected all of the nominations, each nominee will be contacted to determine whether or not they will accept

the nomination and to explain the discernment process to them.

Once the nominee has accepted the nomination, they will attend **one** orientation session. I have scheduled three of these which will be held on May 11, 13, or 17 at 7:00 PM at the Old St. Mary Parish Center. After attending the orientation, all who wish to continue will attend the May Parish Council meeting on May 20th at Holy Rosary. Finally, the actual discernment of new members will take place on Tuesday June 1st.

Next weekend, nomination forms will be in the Sunday bulletin. The forms will also be available in church the weekend of April 24-25. Please prayerfully consider whom you might nominate to serve our parish in this important leadership role. Many new things will be happening over the course of the next few years and Father Tim and I are going to need parishioners with good leadership skills to come forward to assist us in breaking new ground. We have an outstanding parish council here at Three Holy Women and Father Tim and I hope you will consider being a part of it.
