Prison Ministry involves:

- **Visit** those in jail or prison.
- **Letter writing** to prisoners.
- Tutoring,
- **Assisting** with Eucharistic Services and Mass held in the prisons and more.
- **Training** and placement of parishioners wishing to do this ministry is available.
- A **discernment** process is also available for those who want to examine this ministry and reflect on whether they feel called to carry out this ministry.

“Immediately after my first visit, I experienced the privilege of living out Jesus’ message that ‘when I was in prison, you came to visit me’. Visiting the prison is a very humbling experience. I learned that there is really no difference between me and the brother-in-Christ that I visited. Every one of us is a beloved child of God.”
