





FROM YOUR PARISH PRIESTS

Dear friends,

Over the next three weekends, Fr. Mike, Fr. Tim and I want to introduce ourselves and explain the areas of parish life that we will be overseeing at all four parishes. This weekend, it's my turn.

I grew up in Menomonee Falls with my parents and my sister. My sister Andria is 2½ years younger than me. I attended public schools through 8<sup>th</sup> grade and then attended Pius High School from which I graduated in 1978. After high school I did two years at UW-M and then took some time off to figure out what I wanted to do with my life. I entered the College Formation Program at St. Francis Seminary in August, 1985 and continued to pursue my undergraduate degree at Marquette University. I graduated from Marquette in 1988 with a double major in history and philosophy. I began studies for priesthood at St. Francis in August 1988 and was ordained on May 22, 1993. My father continues to live in Menomonee Falls and my sister, her husband and my nephew and niece live in Germantown. Sadly, my mom passed away 3 years ago this coming October.

I have served a number of parishes since my ordination: associate pastor of St. Veronica, Milwaukee (1993-1996), associate pastor of St. Matthias, Milwaukee (1996-2000), pastor of St. Mary, Waukesha (2000-2005), pastor of St. Richard, Racine (2006-2007) and as shared associate pastor of Old St. Mary and Three Holy Women since June of 2008. From 2005-2008 I served as the associate vicar for clergy for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. I have served on the Archdiocesan

Council of Priests, the Archdiocesan Planning Commission, the Archdiocesan Liturgical Commission and the Archdiocesan Building Commission. I was also the chair of the Priest Placement Board for four years.

Archbishop ListECKI has appointed me moderator of the pastoral team. That does not mean I am the pastor with two associates or "the one in charge." All three of us priests are pastors of all four parishes. The moderator serves two functions: to coordinate the work of the pastoral team by promoting communication, consensus and decision making among the members of the team. The moderator is also responsible for reporting to and being accountable to the archbishop and the archdiocese on behalf of the pastoral team in matters concerning the parishes.

In our four parishes, I will be overseeing the areas of parish administration, finance and property, and prayer and worship. I meet with the parish business managers each week and I am meeting with the parish secretaries and the directors of music and liturgy once a month; more often when necessary.

Fr. Mike, Fr. Tim and I all had a great first weekend, each of us presiding at masses at a "new" parish. Your welcome to us could not have been warmer. Many thanks! We all agree that we are off to a great start!
