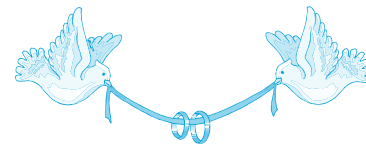

FROM YOUR PARISH PRIESTS

Dear Friends,

In this Sunday's Gospel, we are assured that our loving God will always watch out for us and provide for us. As we continue on our journey in the new pastoral model for the parishes of Riverwest, the Eastside and downtown, Fr. Brian, Fr. Mike and I are so grateful for the opportunity to serve you, our dear parishioners, as we all work together to bring Christ's presence to our parishes. Thank you for all your kindness and support!

This third installment of your priests' stories gives you a brief account of my story and the areas of my responsibility for our parishes. I grew up at St. John's Parish in South Milwaukee, the youngest of the four children of Leo and MaryAnn Kitzke. My father passed away two years ago, and my mom still lives in our family's home. My two sisters and brother are married, and I have 12 nieces and nephews and 10 great-nieces and nephews. I went to St. John's grade school, De Sales Preparatory Seminary, De Sales College Seminary, finishing up at Theological College at the Catholic University of America where I received a bachelor's and master's degree in Philosophy. I did my theological and priestly formation at St. Francis Seminary and the Catholic University of Louvain, where I received a master's in religious studies.

I was ordained 21 years ago, and have served at St. Roman Parish, Holy Family Parish, and for the last 11 years have been here on the eastside, helping St. Hedwig, Holy

Rosary, and St. Rita's to merge into Three Holy Women Parish. Four years ago I was also appointed to Old St. Mary, and as you know, have welcomed Ss. Peter and Paul and Our Lady of Divine Providence into my heart as of July 1st.

As your priests work for you in the greatest privilege in presiding at Eucharist and sharing in the sacramental and formational life that all priests are honored to share in, my specific areas of responsibility are in the area of Adult Formation, ranging from programs like Theology on Tap, Eat, Drink and Be Catholic, the RCIA, Adult Confirmation, Baptism Prep, Marriage Prep, and other areas of adult education and evangelization. I will also watch over our efforts at Pastoral Care, including Hospital and Nursing Home ministries, Bereavement Ministry, as well as ministry to our Seniors. I will also work with Lifelong Faith Formation and help to coordinate the efforts of Eastside Child and Youth Ministry and religious education programs.

Working together with the wonderful staff members, volunteers and parish lay leadership our parishes have been blessed with, please know that Fr. Mike, Fr. Brian and I assure you of our dedication, support, and most of all prayers, as we move forward together for the greater honor and glory of God, and the building up of His Church in service to others!
